Tesco Community Event – ‘Big Weekend’ Neighbourhood Food Collection

Twice a year Tesco have a ‘Big Weekend’ neighbourhood food collection where they top up all donations by 30% to support good causes by enabling them to buy the donated food at a small cost (this covers cost of transport, storage and admin). One of the recipients is The Heart of Kent Hospice who incorporate the food into their menu for the patients, saving them money and putting the savings made into patient care. During next week, from Monday 16th November to Friday 20th November, we shall be collecting food items that are long-life, i.e. canned or dried, such as: canned fruit, vegetables, desserts, canned pies, soup, Longlife milk, cereal, sugar, tea and coffee.
