I would like to offer our congratulations on the improvements to your school's achievement outcomes in 2014.

It is very positive to see the Key Stage 2 results for Level 4+ Reading, Writing and Mathematics combined have improved significantly from 56% to 80%.

It is also good to see that outcomes for Level 5+ have also shown an improvement with 20% for 2014 compared to 6% in 2013, although below floor this still represents a significant improvement and upward trend.

Pupils' progress is very high with two Levels of Progress achieved by 96% for Reading and Mathematics, compared to the previous year's results of 76% (Reading) and 82% (Mathematics).

As a small school, every member of staff should feel they have contributed to these improved outcomes which I am confident are due to a whole school and community effort as well as your effective leadership, well done to everybody.

My team and I look forward to working with you, your staff and Governing Body to ensure these improved results are sustained during 2015 and beyond.
