Why Have a Breakfast Club.

Features of Our Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club will provide before school provision which will be one hour per school day, term time only. It will be school-based and it will provide a healthy breakfast. We will support children's education, support health and nutrition, offer social opportunities including games and activities and offer parents childcare when they want it.

Running the Club

Our breakfast club will be run by a Breakfast Club Supervisor and a Breakfast Club Helper.

It will run from 7:45 am till 8:45 am, Monday to Friday, term time only

Children's Role:

The pupils will be involved in personalising the club and decide on rules for the club. The club will be promoted at school in order to keep interest high.

Rules & Regulations

When serving food we will apply all health & safety regulations to premises, equipment, storage and disposal of waste.

We will keep to the required ratio of supervisors to children which is 1:8

All people working with our children will be cleared by a DBS check to ensure that they don't have convictions for criminal offences relating to children.
