### Sports Premium

At Burham Church of England Primary School we are committed to improving PE and outdoor pursuits.

Since 2014 Funding has been used to:

- ✓ Train a member of staff in the use of our wooded area and purchase equipment for den building and outdoor learning (eg. Logs for sitting on)
- ✓ Buy a shed to hold all of the outdoor equipment
- ✓ Set an expectation that outdoor learning is a routine part of our curriculum and will inspire our children
- ✓ Buy waterproof clothing for every class throughout the school
- ✓ Purchase 'welly racks' so that all children can bring in wellies so that we can use our lovely field all year round
- ✓ Improve our pond area and bought waders for the children to be able to use in its upkeep
- ✓ Buy portable goal posts for the field for the younger children, in addition to our larger fixed goal posts
- ✓ Buy new modern netball posts for the playground
- ✓ Make a dedicated football, netball and basket- ball area on the playground
- ✓ Purchase high vis vests and water bottles for our cross country club so that they can run further afield
- ✓ Buy a Wi Fit and programmes for our Breakfast and After School Clubs
- ✓ Update our PE equipment
- ✓ Update our PE storage
- ✓ Subsidise the cost of clubs for pupils
- ✓ Subsidise the cost of swimming lessons for some pupils
- ✓ Enable staff to go on all available training in order to support their development in PE

In addition we have engaged with 'Change for Life' and local Health and Well Being practitioners who have delivered workshops across the school.
