CR: Hello and welcome to our cyber safety team worship. We have tried to make it funny for you but there are some serious messages in this play.

When I hold my hand up like this (demonstrate) you need to be really quiet and listen.

*Timmy on his laptop; the doorbell rings*

NW: If you help me find my dog I'll give you a lollipop

*Mum hands over her daughter and off they go*

Timmy: hmm I'm not so sure that's a good idea

CA: Oh no! Mum has just let her little child go off with a complete stranger.

*The doorbell rings again; a mature lady (Mrs G (TA)) stands at the door*

Mrs G: Hi I'm Timmy's girlfriend and I've loved chatting to you on line

Timmy: I didn't know she was THAT old!

CA: when they were chatting on line she can't have told Timmy her real age

*The doorbell rings again; 2 nasty looking boys with chains come to the door looking for Timmy*

Timmy: they sounded like quite nice people when we played our game

CA: They don't look like Timmy's friends

Question: asked by the Cyber Safety Team

Whole school: what would you do if you were bullied online?

KS2: who do you interact with on the internet?

KS1: do grown up you on line? How?

Whole school: how many of you go online/on the internet?

Whole school: do you know how to report things that you don't like online?

KS2: do you know what the CEOP button is for?

CA: these are the 4 Golden Rules

- Block them
- Save the evidence
- Tell someone
- Report them
