Data Collection - Fair Processing Privacy Notice

You may have heard of the changes coming on 25th May 2018 when GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) replaces the previous Data Protection. It was approved by the EU Parliament in 2016 and will still affect us even though we are due to leave the European Union.

The simple fact about GDPR is that, for the most part, we will already have in place much of what's needed because many of the requirements are already covered in the current Data Protection Act. We have good ICT practice procedures to protect the information stored on our school management system.

To help our electronic communications remain secure and encrypted we use various systems to transport data and information between schools, KCC, Kent Community Health NHS Foundation Trust and the Department for Education.

We have already updated our Privacy Notice which is sent out to parents on a regular basis and this can be accessed by clicking on this link. We have also updated our Workforce Privacy Notice and distributed it to all members of staff. Our current Data Protection Policy is up to date.
