**Outdoor learning:**

**RE:** LO: What are the signs of new beginnings?

Activity: Taking a walk in springtime to look at signs of both Easter and new life. Discuss what our senses tell us about springtime, how spring differs from the other seasons, including the idea of new life. What signs tell us that Easter is approaching?

**Maths:** LO: To understand the concept of treasure hunts.

Activity: Make a series of mini men out of modelling clay, each one slightly taller than the previous one. Hide the mini-men in different but easy to find locations around the school grounds and mark these on an aerial-view satellite image of the school grounds. Over the course of a day or a week, get the children in groups to find the mini men, starting with the smallest. Each time a mini man is found, the group needs to measure how big he is.

**Science:** LO: To explore the outdoor area.

Activity: Take small group of children to investigate the pond area if accessible and the field/wooded area. What data can they collect about the things they see? How many different plants can you see? What are some of the creatures you can spot called? Can they write the information in a table?
