I would like to offer our congratulations on your school's achievement outcomes in 2018.

It is very positive to see that the school has attained well above average results at Key Stage 2, with 87% of pupils achieving the expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics combined.


It is also good to see strong value added scores in reading, writing and mathematics.

I am pleased that the proportion of pupils reaching the expected standard at the end of Key Stage 1 was above the emerging national average across all subjects. Pupils also achieved well at the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage (85.7%).
