PE Kits should be sent to school in a PE bag that will be left in school. They will be sent home at the end of each term for washing and checking.

Earrings must be removed for PE and Swimming (Swimming Years 5 and 6 only). Items of jewellery including rings should not be worn to school.

Hair for school must be tied back if long enough from Health and Safety reasons. Extreme hair styles for boys or girls are not suitable for school. Make up or nail varnish should not be worn to school.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast Club runs every morning during term time from 7.45am - 8.45am which includes care and a healthy breakfast.

After School Club

After School Club runs every afternoon from 3.30pm until 5.30pm, (6.00pm by special advance arrangement).

Healthy Eating

Caterlink provide our healthy meals and at times packed lunches. Other children prefer to bring their own healthy packed lunch. (We would ask that no peanuts are packed in lunches due to allergies). Children may have school meals on a weekly basis or on individual days of the week. Payment for school meals is via Parent Pay. All children in KS1 are entitled to a free school meal so no payment is required.

Sweets are not allowed at school but children may bring fruit, which has been prepared and wrapped at home, to eat during the morning break.

Children in KS1 get free fruit to eat during morning break.

Children under 5 are entitled to free milk at school and those over 5 can also have milk at a cost to the parent. Parents must register for this (both free and paid for) at coolmilk.com. Please see the leaflet provided to you or ask at reception.
